All students who completed the program between 07/01/09 and 06/30/10, passed the State licensure examinations (practical and written), and were hired for a job within the cosmetology field. Graduates were tracked using alumni surveys, state data systems, social media websites, etc. The response rate to alumni surveys was approximately 71%. The placement rate is typically based on completers who were employed within 180 days of graduating and were employed for at least 12 weeks. The institution is required to report the job placement rate to the National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts & Sciences, Inc. (NACCAS).
